Job Summary:

- To assist with the promotion and administrative matters of the Mending Broken Hearts research project. The project will be looking at Indigenous Knowledge around heart health and wellbeing, as well as Indigenous women’s experiences of cardiovascular disease and their relationship with their caregivers.

Minimum Requirements

- Must have their Grade 12 diploma or equivalent
- Must have own source of transportation
- Must have 1-2 years of experience in a First Nation administrative role
- Must have own computer and be comfortable operating general MS Office programs
- Must have excellent communication skills, both written and verbal
- Ability to work well under pressure with limited supervision

Assets

- Knowledge of the Anishnaabe language
- Interest in building research skills and community research capacity
- Experience in community research or event coordination

Other Info

- Flexibility of hours is required
- Position will require the consultant to occasionally travel to and from the McMaster University Campus

- As per the funding agreement, a maximum of \$15,000/year will be provided to this project. A monthly stipend will be provided, inclusive of travel and administrative costs.
