- Contributing to the development of services and programs for the Addiction Medicine Program
- Providing clients with harm reduction advice and materials
- Arranging for walk-in patients to be sent to nearby emergency departments if medically necessary
- Connecting client to primary provider if needed
- Treating and screening for substance abuse concerns
- Providing care that reflects an understanding and competent knowledge of health and other issues facing the Aboriginal community
